


Fig. 1 A heuristic model for the empirical study of integration processes. Source: Penninx & Garcés–Mascareñas (2016, p. 16)




Fig. 1 A heuristic model for the empirical study of integration processes. Source: Penninx & Garcés–Mascareñas (2016, p. 16)
